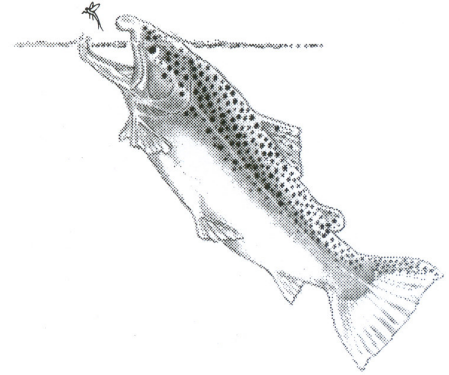

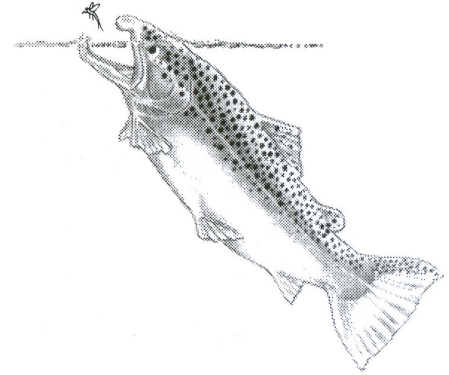

** Bead Head San Juan Worm	4,10,12,14,16	Worm brown & brown, red and liver

### **D) STREAMERS**

* Clouser Minnow	1/0	Green & gold, green & white
* Egg Sucking Leech	2, 4	Black, purple
** Bead Head Woolly Bugger	4, 6, 8	black & green, black & brown
* Bead Head Lite Brite Zonkers	4, 6	Olive, white, black
**Spuddler	4, 6	Rust, brown
* Marabou Muddlers	4, 6	Brown, black, white
* Kiwi Muddler	2, 4	Natural colour

\*\*Note: A) The flies that appear with one asterisk in front of them are must have patterns if you have to limit your self to a limited number of flies or are on a limited budget.

B) The flies that appear with two asterisks in front of them are patterns that are very nice to have for trout that have become selective or you have a little extra cash flow. This will allow you to be prepared for those times when a really large trout is being picky and you really want a high percentage chance of a solid hook up.

This basic list is a simple must have selection of fly patterns that will carry you through an entire fishing season on our Southern and Central Alberta trout streams. As with any list it can never be complete, this list is meant to make fly pattern selection a pleasant experience for the individual who is new to fly fishing or fishing in this area of Alberta.

If you find you need help in fly selection or seem to have areas that are lacking in your fly selection after perusing this list and purchasing your own fly arsenal. Please drop by the shop we would be very happy to help out where ever we can. The shop has a very complete selection of flies which is composed of five various brands (manufacturers) and eight various price breaks or levels. We carry or will custom tie what we feel is the best selection of flies at different price levels that is likely to be found any where in Central Alberta. As well we will send out fly orders via mail if you are out of the local area and cannot make it into the shop. We really hope the following list will make fly selection an easier process for many anglers. Remember to use this list in conjunction with our hatch chart for the Red Deer River.
